If you are 72 years old or older and are required to take a minimum distribution from your IRA retirement account (e.g. IRA's, SEP, Simple IRA), you may want to consider designating a portion of this withdrawal as a charitable donation. The charitable donation must be sent directly to the charitable organization (e.g. House of Charity, St. Thomas, etc.). The portion of the RMD that is donated to charity would not be federally taxed up to \$100,000.
