

Baptisms

Liturgy and Life

The woman afflicted with hemorrhages for twelve years from today's Gospel did not suffer alone. Many women across time and cultures deal with bleeding issues, particularly around menstruation. While a healthy aspect of life for most women, menstruation continues to be stigmatized. Many women are made to feel embarrassed about their periods, and little research is done on menstrual cycles compared to other health issues. Further, women throughout the world struggle to find access to sufficient supplies—tampons, pads, pain medication, or tolets with running water. UNICEF reports that 2.3 billion people around the globe lack basic sanitation services, which presents a major challenge for women on their periods. 
