



## All Souls Month & Remembrance Mass

Traditionally, the month of November is set aside to remember our loved ones who have gone home to the Lord. Our tradition here at St. Thomas the Apostle Parish is to have a weekend in November dedicated to our Parishioners who have died in the past year (October 2022 – October 2023). Our Remembrance Masses will be on the weekend of **November 4 & 5**.

A scroll will be placed next to the Ambo (pulpit) and will be displayed from November 2 (All Souls Day) through the end of November. It will include the names of those Parishioners who have died in the past year. During the Prayer of the Faithful at the 4:00pm, 8:00am, 9:30am and 11:00am Masses, we will read the names of those who have died this past year. While the names are being read, we will toll the church bells and at the end of the Prayer of the Faithful, the Priest will close with a special Blessing Prayer. This way, those who have passed will be remembered and no matter which mass you attend, whether in person or virtually, anyone in your family may experience this beautiful ceremony. We believe this will be a beautiful way to remember your loved ones. Reminder: we are continuing to live stream our 9:30 am Sunday Mass.
