

Liturgy and Life

Jesus raises questions of identity in today's Gospel: Who do people say I am? Who do you say that I am? His questions point to the reality that much of our identities get shaped by other people. In addition to our individual characteristics, we may identify as a parent, teammate, coworker, partner, or friend. These identities are often sources of deep meaning - and at times, profound heartache. Relationships are messy. In abusive situations, one person may wrongly tell another that they are useless or bothersome. It can be difficult not to internalize verbal insults about our identity. Affirm the identities of three people you encounter today. Affirm something about your own identity as well.


